Noah's Inclusion Services provides a range of inclusion services to children and young people with a disability aged 0-18 years. It is a multi-disciplinary and transdisciplinary, family centred service.

The Speech Pathologists will be required to provide an efficient and effective Speech Pathology service to children 0 – 18 years who live in the Shoalhaven and Illawarra. This may include 1:1 intervention, group intervention, consultation or home programming for acquired or developmental delays and disorders as the position requires. The position will require you to work independently in a transdisciplinary or multidisciplinary manner. The position is based in Nowra however you will be required, at times, to work in the wider Shoalhaven and Illawarra community. Home visiting may be required.

Applicants should have a commitment to evidence based practice principles and an understanding of best practice in early childhood intervention. Applicants should also demonstrate an ability to work in a transdisciplinary and/or multidisciplinary team, using family centred and strength based approaches and have paediatric experience.

Applicants must have a recognised degree in Speech Pathology as well as membership of Speech Pathology Australia and a willingness to undertake professional self regulation leading to Certified Practising Speech Pathologist (CPSP) status.
